Article 1: Participants

This contest is free and open to all students enrolled in French classes at the following levels:

- Elementary School
- Middle School
- High School
- Universities

And in the following states: Alabama, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Mississippi, and Tennessee.

Article 2: Terms of Participation

Each participating student creates a comic strip according to the format detailed in Article 3.

Article 3: Format

The comic strip will be submitted on one or more sheets of paper (Letter size).

Only the originals should be submitted (no photocopies)

Article 4: Presentation and Content

- The theme is open
- Text, written in French, must be present in each panel (box).
- The comic strip may consist of 3 panels (boxes), 6 panels or more...

Article 5: Sending in Your Work

- Originality of theme
